ENERGY CHATS

Our biweekly **Energy Chats** bring in experts from industry, academia, and government to discuss pressing topics in energy. Past sessions have featured Hayley Ryan (ExxonMobil, Low Carbon Solutions), Professor Jung-Ho Lew (Georgia Tech, Distributed Energy Resources), and Ben Damani (Cherry Street Energy). These events give students access to real-world insights and diverse perspectives shaping the future of energy.

NETWORKING EVENTS

Held monthly, our networking events connect students with professionals, researchers, and faculty. Highlights include a **“Day in the Life” panel** with GE Vernova, hands-on workshops, and business mixers. These events foster meaningful relationships and help establish ECGT as a hub for energy-focused collaboration across campus and industry.



OUR IMPACT

FACILITY TOURS

We organize exclusive tours to high-impact energy sites, from data centers and utilities to microgrids and R&D labs. These trips offer students real-world exposure to energy infrastructure and operations, while also enabling face time with engineers and decision-makers in the field.

PROJECTS

The Energy Club supports student-led projects that explore innovative solutions to real-world energy challenges. Past and ongoing efforts include a **Piezoelectric Sidewalk** to harvest energy from footsteps, a **Collapsible Solar Array** for deployable clean energy, and a **Bike-to-Power Generator** that converts pedaling into electricity. We've also participated in national competitions like the **DOE Solar Decathlon** and the **Solar District Cup**, showcasing our team's technical creativity and commitment to sustainability.



SOUTHEASTERN ENERGY CONFERENCE

The Southeastern Energy Conference is a full-day event that brings together professionals from research, industry, and policy to share insights on today's evolving energy landscape. The conference features opening and closing keynotes, student-moderated expert panels, and an industry showcase highlighting companies across the sector. A student research symposium rounds out the event, where selected projects are presented and judged by a panel of experts.
